Unpack the machine and check the components

USB cable

It is recommended to use a USB 2.0 cable (Type A/B) that is no more than 2 meters (6 feet) long.

Network cable

Use a straight-through Category5 (or greater) twisted-pair cable for 10BASE-T or 100BASE-TX Fast Ethernet Network.



Remove the packing material from the machine

IMPORTANT

DO NOT connect the AC power cord yet.

Remove the packing tape from the outside of the machine and the silica gel pack from the face-down output tray.

Load paper in the paper tray

- Pull the paper tray completely out of the machine.
- While pressing the green paper-guide release lever, slide the paper guides to fit the paper size you are loading in the tray. Make sure that the guides are firmly in the slots.



🖉 Note

For Legal or Folio size paper, press the release button in the bottom of the paper tray and then pull out the back of the paper tray.

(Legal or Folio size paper are not available in some regions.)



• Fan the stack of paper well to avoid paper jams and misfeeds.

Put paper in the tray and make sure:

■The paper is below the maximum paper mark (▼ ▼ ▼).

Over filling the paper tray will cause paper jams.

- The side to be printed on must be face down.
- The paper guides touch the sides of the paper so it will feed properly.



- Put the paper tray firmly back in the machine. Make sure that it is completely inserted into the machine.

Before you begin

First you must configure the wireless network settings of your machine to communicate with your network access point/router. After the machine is configured to communicate with your access point/router, computers on your network will have access to the machine. To use the machine from these computers, you will need to install the printer driver. The following steps will guide you through the configuration and installation process.

IMPORTANT

- If you are going to connect the machine to your network, we recommend that you contact your system administrator prior to installation. You must know your wireless network settings before you proceed with this installation.
- If you have previously configured the wireless settings of the machine, you must reset the print server back to its factory default settings.
 - 1. Turn off the machine.
 - 2. Make sure that the front cover is closed and the power cord is plugged in.
 - 3. Hold down Go as you turn on the power switch. Keep Go pressed down until all the LEDs light up and then Ready LED turns off.
 - 4. Release Go. Make sure that all the LEDs turn off.
 - 5. Press Go six times. Make sure that all the LEDs light up to indicate the print server has been reset to its factory default settings. The machine will restart.

🖉 Note

 To achieve optimum results with normal everyday document printing, place the Brother machine as close to the network access point/router as possible with minimal obstructions. Large objects and walls between the two devices as well as interference from other electronic devices can affect the data transfer speed of your documents.

Due to these factors, wireless may not be the best method of connection for all types of documents and applications. If you are printing large files, such as multi-page documents with mixed text and large graphics, you may want to consider choosing wired Ethernet for a faster data transfer or USB for the fastest throughput speed.

- Although the Brother HL-2270DW can be used in both a wired and wireless network, only one of the connection methods can be used at a time.
- The screens are based on HL-2270DW.
